



Health and Safety at Work – Policy Statement

Intersafe Ltd will comply with its obligations under Section 2 of the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 to provide a safe place of work so far as reasonably practicable, which is without risks to health by:

- To take reasonable care for the health and safety of themselves and of other person who may be affected by their acts or omissions at work.
- To co-operate with Management in matters of Health and Safety.
- Not to misuse items provided for safety.
